Lessons for Our Lives:

**DID YOU NOTICE:**

Genesis 12:10-20 Sarah was considered “beautiful” at age 65 (see I Peter 3:5,6). When husband didn’t protect her, but handed her over; God protected her

Genesis 16:1-6 trying to “rush” God’s will, resulted in problems (source of Arab/Israeli conflict today)

Genesis 17:15-21 Even after mistreating servant (whom God also protected), was part of God’s plan in Fulfilling covenant with Abram. Isaac (to laugh) was named, BEFORE Sarah laughed about upcoming Pregnancy in old age.

Genesis 20:1-14 Sarah was considered “beautiful” at age 90+ (see I Peter 3:5,6) When husband didn’t protect her, but handed her over; God protected her

Genesis 49:31,32 Family burial plot: Abram, Sarah, Isaac, Rebekah and Leah (later Jacob & Joseph)

Isaiah 51:1,2 Israelites reminded of their heritage from SARAH

Galatians 4:23, 24 Sarah is compared to the New Covenant , new Jerusalem. Christians are children of “Sarah”
